Bargates - No. 15 (Rumsey and Rumsey); No. 25 (Old London Brewery); No. 27; Nos. 29 and 31; Christchurch Baptist Church (49); Priory Coaches Garage (Demolished); Nos. 66 - 72 (even); No. 74; Nos. 76 - 84 (even); No. 86 (Post Office) (now includes 37, 39 and 41 Twynham Avenue); Nos. 94 - 102 (even); Nos. 108 and 110.

Bridge Street - Gas works (building on street frontage only); Nos. 1 and 2 Willow Place; No. 3 Willow Place; No. 22; Avon Bank (36); Nos. 42 and 44 (also includes 44a); No. 46; Nos. 52 and 54; No. 56; No. 70; Nos. 74 - 78 (even)

Burley Road - Nos. 1 - 4 (consec); No. 6; No. 39 (Honeysuckle) Cottage and Horn Cottage; Farmhouse at Lower Clockhouse Farm.

Castle Street - Nos. 8 and 10.

Chewton Common Road - Rose Cottage (27); Gorse Cottage (31); No. 37; No. 47 (Sundial Cottage).

Chewton Farm Road - West Lodge (1); Lodge to north of west lodge (3); Barn at Chewton Glen Farm; Granary at Chewton Glen Farm; Buildings around courtyard at Chewton Glen Farm (9).

Christchurch Road - Cottages opposite Home Farm (15) (1, 2 and 3 Red Cottages); Keepers Cottage, Quomps Copse; Home Farm House (including attached farm building to south) (4); Builders Merchants Store (eastern part only) (4).

Church Lane - Nos. 1 and 2 Priory Place (now known as Priory View).

Cranemoor Avenue - No. 2 Former Lodge to Cranemoor (now located in Hinton Wood Avenue).

Cranemoor Gardens - Cranemoor Gardens No. 2.

Hawthorn Road - Hawthorn Cottage (now 1 and 2 Hawthorn Road)

High Street - No. 19; No. 25 (now includes 25A); No. 31; No. 45; No. 67; Nos. 2 and 4 (now 4 and 6 High Street and 1, 3 and 5 Pound Lane); Nos. 38 and 38a (now 38 and 40); No. 46; Nos. 52, 52a and 54; Nos. 56, 58, 60, 62, 62a; Nos. 64; No. 66 (now 66 and 68); Nos. 68 and 70 (now 70 and 72)

Hinton Wood Avenue - Cranemoor Lodge

Meadow Lane - April Cottage

Mill Lane - Cottage opposite Mill Copse (Mill House)

Millhams Street - Nos. 10 - 13 (consec); No. 14 (Coachmans Cottage); (now address is Duckingstool Lane); Nos. 16a and 17a Barn opposite No. 16; No. 16 (Bay Tree Cottage) and No. 17; Nos. 19 - 25 (consec) (now 18 - 24).

Mudford - The Watch House (now address is Coastguard Way); Outbuilding to east of Avonmouth Hotel (95); Seabrook Cottage (No. 99); No. 97 (Bridge House); Sunnyholme and adjoining cottage to the west (demolished); Outbuilding at and to west of Mudford Lodge; Mount Pleasant (No. 111); Street boundary wall at Mount Pleasant; Lodge at Sandhills (No. 155); Nos. 1 and 2 Prospect Cottage (Nos. 48 and 50).

Mudford Quay - Haven Inn (now Haven House Inn); Little Haven; Gentle Calm and adjoining cottage (Nos. 5 and 6).

Parley Lane - Farm building to north west of Parley Court Farmhouse; Farmhouse at Hurn Bridge Farm; L Shaped range of farm buildings to south west of farmhouse.

Purewell - Nos. 2 and 4; No. 6 (eastern half only); No. 10; No. 12; Nos. 14 and 16 (now demolished); Catholic Church of the Immaculate Conception and St Joseph; The Presbytery (No. 67).

Salisbury Road - No. 116 (Pine Tree Cottage); No. 118 (Burton Green House); Cart shed at Burton Green Farm (No. 122); Burton Hall Lodge (No. 180); Holmefield Cottage; Winkton Lodge Cottage; Fisherman's Haunt Hotel; No. 21 (Dairy House); Farmhouse at Burton Farm (No. 31); No. 131 Burton, Church of England School; No. 159 (Burton Farmhouse); Cottage (next north of Gosfield Cottage) (now known as The Orchard).
